IF IN EYES: hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently for 15 -20 minutes, remove contacts

IF SWALLOWED: Call Poison center, have person sip a glass of water – Do not induce vomiting

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take contaminated clothing off , rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 -20 minutes

INHALED move person to fresh air – If respiratory symptoms persist, get medical attention

IF IN EYES: hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently for 15 -20 minutes, remove contacts

IF SWALLOWED: Call Poison center, DO NOT GIVE ANY liquid, Do not induce vomiting unless told by poison control center

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take contaminated clothing off, rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 -20 minutes

INHALED move person to fresh air – If respiratory symptoms persist, get medical attention

INHALATION: Move exposed person(s) to fresh air, if not breathing call 911 give Mouth to Mouth CALL

SKIN CONTACT: Take off contaminated clothing/shoes. Wash exposed area with water for at least 15 minutes.

EYE CONTACT: Flush with water for at least 15 minutes. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.

INGESTION: Rinse mouth out with water, give small sips of water. Do not induce vomiting unless directed to. Seek medical attention if feeling sick or nauseous.

****NyGuard IGR Concentrate EPA 1021-1603 EMERGENCY 800-424-9300**

EYE CONTACT: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment

SKIN CONTACT: Take off the contaminated clothing. Rinse the skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

INGESTION: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

INHALATION: Remove person to fresh air. If not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

EYE CONTACT: Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with clean water. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.

SKIN CONTACT: Wash with soap and water.

INGESTION: If more than one (1) to two (2) ounces are ingested, induce vomiting and seek medical attention.

INHALATION: Remove victim to fresh air. Contact a physician if warranted
